LIFE RANK REQUIREMENTS

WHILE A STAR SCOUT, TAKE PART IN SERVICE PROJECT(S) TOTALING AT LEAST SIX HOURS OR WORK. THESE MUST BE APPROVED BY YOUR SCOUTMASTER.
