- Volunteer STAR Reading tutors work with individual students for Reading under our STAR Reading Coordinators direction. One-half of our coordinator's salary is paid with TrustLands monies, the other half with an AmeriCorps grant.
- Debbie and Kristy tutor younger students, under our English Language Arts Coordinator, for Reading.
