Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) for School Year 2021-2022

Some families with students in qualifying P-EBT schools, will receive P-EBT benefits for the days school meals could not be accessed due to COVID-19 between the months of September 2021 through May 2022.

Students must be certified as eligible for free or reduced-price meals through the National School Lunch Program during the current school year. Receiving meals at no cost this year does not automatically qualify your student for P-EBT. Contact the Nutrition Services Department if your household needs to confirm eligibility or apply for free or reduced-price meal benefits. Household applications must be submitted to Nutrition Services no later than May 6, 2022, to determine free or reduced-price meal eligibility for P-EBT benefits.
