Essential Skills

The priority standards consist of the following skills:

- Geographic Literacy: Demonstrate spatial and landscape understanding using globes, maps, and photographs.
- Historical Thinking: Demonstrate historical thinking practices including change and continuity over time, cause and effect relationships, interpretation of primary and secondary sources, and significance of historical events and figures.
- Civic Mindedness: Demonstrate understanding of civic roles, rights, and responsibilities at various levels: the individual, group, government, and global.
- Economic Understanding: Demonstrate knowledge of economic concepts and elements of financial literacy.

- a. Understand how the exploration and colonization of North America transformed human history. (Historical Thinking, Geographic Literacy)
- b. Understand the chronology and significance of key events leading to self-government. (Historical Thinking, Civic Mindedness)
- c. Understand the rights and responsibilities guaranteed in the United States Constitution and Bill of Rights. (Civic Mindedness)
- d. Understand that the 19th century was a time of incredible change for the United States, including geographic expansion, constitutional crisis, and economic growth. (Gegoraphic Literacy, Historical Thinking, Economic Understanding)
- e. Address the causes, consequences and implications of the emergence of the United States as a world power. (Historical Thinking, Economic Understanding)
