Vae View will educate teachers and staff on effective ways to communicate with and reach out to parents by:

- Implementing and coordinating parent programs that build ties between parents and the school, and
- Training staff members to utilize parents as equal partners.

Vae View will coordinate with Head Start, other preschool programs, and parent resource centers to involve parents in the education of their children by:

- Informing parents of programs and resources available,
- Offering on-site parenting classes in conjunction with Parent Information Resource Center (PIRC), and
- Organizing a Kindergarten Round-Up for Pre-K students.

Vae View will ensure that information related to school programs, meetings, and activities is sent home in a format and, to the extent practicable, language the parents can understand by:

- Translating key documents and posting translated documents on the school website, and
- Providing opportunities for parents with limited English and disabilities to participate.

Vae View will provide reasonable access to parents by:

- Providing opportunities for consultation at ILP conferences, during planning time (upon request), by email or phone call, and
- Providing opportunities for parents to volunteer, observe, or take part in the classroom.

Vae View will provide support for reasonable activities parents may request.
