- Playwriting: Use correct form and structure to create a scene or play with a beginning, middle, and end that includes full character development, believable dialogue, and logical plot outcomes.
- Characterization: Explore and sustain physical, vocal, and emotional choices to develop a performance that is believable, authentic, and relevant to a drama/theatre work.

Perform

- Rehearsal Etiquette/Ensemble: Perform as a productive and responsible member of an acting ensemble in both rehearsal and performance situations.
- Perform: Memorize and present a drama/theatre work using creative processes that shape the production for a specific audience.

Respond

- Justify or defend responses based on personal experiences when participating in or observing a drama/theatre work.
