ABC-CLIO is a collection of databases of information for use in teaching social studies classes. Davis School District has adopted ten of the databases to be used as primary instructional materials. The majority of instructional materials for each course should come from the principal database. Teachers for all courses may find useful sources in the supplementary databases.

Protocol for Using Resources

3. Ensure that the resource is being used to build student's background knowledge or develop essential skills as identified in the **DESK Proficiency Scales**.
4. Preview all materials in their entirety before using in instruction.
